THE CASS COUNTY HISTORICAL & GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY



Cass County's first courthouse was built in 1838. Dr. Henry Hall donated fifteen acres to the county to build a two-story courthouse in Virginia. In 1843 the county seat was moved to Beardstown and the courthouse became known as the North School. In 1872 Virginia regained the county seat and moved into a new brick courthouse on the square in Virginia.

Cass County is one of Illinois' smallest; however, its location puts it on the road in which many early settlers followed. The Illinois River forms Cass County's western border; this natural waterway brought the early traders and trappers from the north to the Mississippi River and Missouri River. Settlers came down the Ohio River and followed the Mississippi River northward by way of the Illinois River into the fertile prairie of Cass County. Cass County was formed in 1837 out of Morgan County. Prior to 1823 both counties were part of Sangamon County.

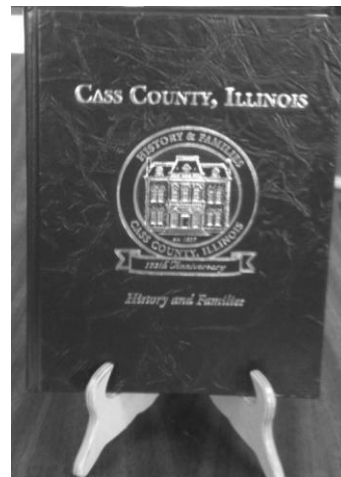
