The son of Chris **AHERNKILL**, age 4, died Monday, buried in Newmansville Cemetery - source- Ashland Sentinel, Ashland, Illinc

Mrs. A.J. **BAST**, age 28, died March 11. Interred Ashland Cemetery. Leaves husband and 4 young children - source - Ashland Sent

Mrs.**BEELY** buried Arenzville Cemetery, December 3. She was born in England in 1804 and came here in 1841 - source - Virginia

A terrible accident last week resulted in the death of Mrs. R. **BEGGS**. She was kicked by a horse and died the third day. - source 1881

The son of F.M. **BRIGGS**, age 7, died March 3. Buried Beardstown City Cemetery - source - Beardstown Illinoian, March 10, 1881

Pauline, (Mrs. F.M. **BRIGGS**) died April 5, 1899. Her maiden name was **REDDICK**.

Ophelia, wife of Andrew **BROWN** and dau. of U. **ISHAM**, died of consumption at her residence Friday. Interred Newmansville ce Gazette, January 25, 1884

Florence, age 9, dau. of Henry **CARPENTER**, died October 16, and buried at Oak Grove cemetery. - source - Beardstown Illinoiar

Died February 15, David **CHAMBERLAIN**, age 70. Was employed as a tailor. His sister of Princeton was notified, buried Beardst Beardstown Illinoian, February 19, 1880

Marguerite, infant of Mr. and Mrs. A.S. **COIL**, age 3 months, died Saturday. - source Beardstown Illinoian, August 29, 1893

Lorna/Loma **CROUCH**, age 20, died May 5 in Sangamon Bottoms. Interred Lutheran cemetery. - source - Beardstown Illinoian, M

Mrs. Richard **DENNIS** was buried at the Beardstown Catholic cemetery Sunday. - source - Beardstown Illinoian, March 18, 1880

Noah **FARROW** died in Chandlerville, Monday, age 74. Interred in cemetery there. Married Catherine **SHELBY** 40 years ago, chi Samuel. - source - Virginia Enquirer, August 26, 1897

Etta, wife of R.B. **FULKS** died Friday. Interred in Oak Grove cemetery, was 27. - source - Virginia Gazette, January 9, 1885

John **HERN** young man living in this county, died Friday and buried Catholic cemetery, Beardstown, Saturday. His parents resid Illinoian, December 19, 1878

Willis **HUBBS** of near Ashland, died June 18, 1889 and buried City cemetery there. He was born August 18, 1866 and died of con Sentinel, June 22, 1889

An infant of John **IVENGER** (might be IVEMEIER) died Saturday. Interred Lutheran cemetery in Beardstown - source - Virginia t

Died April 1 after a long illness, Mrs. Thomas **JAMES**, at Ashland. Buried City cemetery there. - source - Virginia Gazette, April 8

Died April 15, in Beardstown, Frederick **KAULE**, age 79. He was born in Millburg, Germany, came to Chicago and then here in 18 business until 1880. Married Catherine **SNELL** in 1843. Children are E.O. **KAULE**, F.A. **KAULE**, and Emma **WARNKE**, also decea tery. - source - Beardstown Enterprise, April 17, 1887

Died Tuesday, in Beardstown, an infant of Henry **KLUMBERGER**. Interred City cemetery there. - source - Virginia Gazette, July

Mrs. **MULLEN**, an old lady died Monday. Interred Chandlerville. - source - Virginia Gazette, October 21, 1881

Jacob **RENTZSCH** died Monday at Mt. Pulaski, Illinois. The body was removed to Chandlerville. He was born March 28, 1876 in by father and two brothers. Proceeded in death by mother, 3 brothers and 1 sister. - source - Virginia Gazette, December 20, 190

A murder, suicide or natural death occurred April 15, on the C.B. and Q. tracks in Schuyler County to James **RICE**. Interred in Be source - Beardstown Enterprise, Tuesday, April 18, 1899 *See story in Miscellaneous Articles and Stories - A Mystery

Died Saturday, August 26, Mrs. Mary Ann **ROSE**, age 70. Service from St. Alexius Catholic Church, Beardstown. Interred Beard c Illinoisian, August 29, 1893

Died January 9, 10 miles east of here, Frances **RYAN**. She was born February 8, 1815 in Kentucky. Her maiden name was **GAINS SCHAEFFER** who died in 1853 and later Pierce **RYAN** in 1858 who is ill with lung fever. She leaves 6 children. - source - Illinoisian

Clay **SINCLAIR** died, the result of a train accident last Thursday. He was born in Morgan Co., Illinois, June 14, 1844 and married with three children. Interred in Ashland, Tuesday. - source - Virginia Gazette, March 2, 1888

Died January 14 in Ashland at the home of her granddaughter, Mrs. Mylo **LEE**, Jamina **STATEN**. She married Daniel **STATEN** and husband in Oak Grove cemetery in Beardstown. She also leaves a dau., Mrs. Frank **LOHMAN**. - source - Ashland Sentinel, Januar

Aaron **STOUT** of near Chandlerville has died. He leaves a wife and 4 children. (One obituary states he was buried at Ashland, ar Yatesville cemetery.)

James **TAYLOR** died at the Poor Farm in Bluff Springs, November 12. Unless his body is claimed he will be interred in Potters Fi Illinoisian Star, November 13, 1897

An infant dau. of Robert **THOMAS** died last Saturday. Burial was Monday at Mt. Olive Church. - source - Virginia Gazette, Septe

Mrs. Judith **TOLES/TWOLES**, age 54, died at the residence of Henry **DICK**, June 5, of breast cancer. - source - Chandlerville Inde

The mother of William **WIGGENS** died at his residence, December 10. Interred at Newmansville. - source - Virginia Gazette, Dec

The infant dau. of C.E. **WYMAN**, age 10 months, died Sunday of Cholera Infantum. - source - Beardstown Illinoisian, 1879

William **ZIRKLE**, age 75, died August 20. Interred Mt. Olive cemetery near Chandlerville. - source - Ashland Sentinel, August 26
